There are four **opening prayers** at the Sunday Eucharist: *English* - varies from Sunday to Sunday; *Korean* - "Merciful Lord, with all our heart, may we adore you and love all the people truly"; *Spanish* - This also varies from Sunday to Sunday; *Kanjabal (a Mayan dialect)* - "God, our Father, we always follow Jesus. May he breathe on us his saving Spirit. We pray in his name." The **Apostles' Creed** is on page 162 in the Gather Book. At the **Greeting of Peace**, "Peace be with you" is added in Hebrew and Arabic as our prayer for peace in the Holy Land. *Shalom aleichem* in Hebrew and *Asalamu aleikum* in Arabic.
